#### 6. Orlando climate / Area attractions

#### July Weather

Average daytime high 92° F (33° C)
Average nighttime low 73° F (22° C)
Average monthly rainfall 8.1 inches (20 cm)

Orlando has a warm and humid subtropical climate, and there are two major seasons each year. One of those seasons is hot and rainy, lasting from May until October (roughly coinciding with the Atlantic hurricane season). The area's warm and humid climate is caused primarily by its low elevation and its position relatively close to the Tropic of Cancer, and much of its weather is affected by the movement of the Gulf Stream.

During the height of Orlando's very humid summer season, temperatures rarely fall below 70° F (21° C), and daytime highs average in the 90s (32-37° C). Although the city rarely records temperatures over 100° F (38° C), extreme humidity often pushes the heat index to over 110° F (45° C). During these months, strong afternoon thunderstorms occur almost daily.

The average annual rainfall in Orlando is 50.1 inches (128 cm), most of it occurring in the period from June to September.

Orlando is best known for the many tourist attractions in the area, in particular the nearby Walt Disney World Resort, located in Lake Buena Vista about 20 miles south of Orlando, that features four amusement parks. Other notable area attractions include Sea World and Universal Studios Orlando, also featuring amusement parks. The region sees an estimated 52 million tourists a year.

Orlando has the second largest number of hotel rooms in the country (after Las Vegas, Nevada), and is one of the busiest American cities for conferences and conventions with the Orange County Convention Center, the country's second largest in square footage. It is also known for its wide array of golf courses, with numerous courses available for any level of golfer.

#### 14. Playing Uniform / Advertising

Players shall wear a standard uniform approved by their national federation. Individual variations only in player's name and sponsors (advertisements) are permitted – see Item d) below. Boys must wear pants or slacks.

The name of the country must appear on the uniform.

The following may appear on the uniform:

- a) Name of player
- b) Logo of the country or member federation which the player represents
- c) Advertisements, provided the area of each advertisement is less than the area of the country's name on the player's back and does not conflict with the law of the country of the host federation. The number of advertisements is decided by each federation.
- d) Two individual badges on the sleeves of each player's uniform, provided the player's federation has authorized the player(s) to have individual advertisements.
